With very little notice, NB Power has announced that remaining provincial incentives are coming to an end. Both residential *and* commercial owners have only until May 27th to register to receive the following grant amounts.

Residential homeowners stand to miss out on up to \$3000.

Commercial business owners stand to miss out on up to \$250,000.

Also worth noting; NB Power has proposed changes to the existing net metering program. All indications show that the future proposed program *will not be nearly as good* for the customer as the current program. It has been proposed that those who get on the current net metering program will be grandfathered on the current program. These two announcements (loss of incentives and proposed net metering changes) have caused a major uptake in customers wanting to get their 'foot in the door' before any changes.
